

You got **married**. Congratulations!

Add reviewing health insurance to your to-do list now. You have only a limited time to act, depending on what type of coverage you have.

If you or your spouse already has coverage, update your health plan once you get married.

Your coverage type	Why you should update	How to make the update	Deadline to update
Oregon Health Plan (OHP)	To reassess eligibility for benefits for you, your spouse, and dependents	Call OHP client services: 800-273-0557 (toll-free). If you have an online account, you can log in at One.Oregon.gov instead of calling.	Within 15 days of your marriage
Through your employer's plan	To see if you can add your spouse and dependents to your plan	Talk to your employer or the human resources department at your job.	Within 30 days of your marriage
A health plan you got through HealthCare.gov	To add your spouse and dependents to your plan, and to see if you qualify for a new amount of financial help	Log in to your account at HealthCare.gov or call 800-318-2596 (toll-free).	Within 60 days of your marriage

Get covered if you don't have health insurance

If you are uninsured, marriage is a good time to think about getting covered. Not only can health insurance help protect your family's health and finances, your marriage may allow you to enroll in a health plan at **HealthCare.gov** (also called a Marketplace plan), even when open enrollment is closed.

- Now that you are married, you and your spouse may qualify for a special enrollment period if one of you has had health insurance at least one day in the past 60 days.
- If you and your spouse meet income and residency requirements, you may qualify for the **Oregon Health Plan**. You can enroll in the Oregon Health Plan at any time.

Update HealthCare.gov as your family grows and your life changes

If you have a Marketplace plan, other changes you should report to **HealthCare.gov** include:

- The birth, adoption, or placement of a child in your home
- Getting or losing a job
- Moving to a new address
- Gaining or losing eligibility for employer coverage or the Oregon Health Plan
- Any other change that affects your family size, income, or enrollment
