

Attention COFA Premium Assistance Applicants

During this COVID-19 pandemic, we encourage everyone to be safe, stay home. In support of this, we have extended the last day you can submit documents to be paid back for 2019 medical expenses to June 30, 2020. We can pay you back for costs you paid for with copies of your explanation of benefits (EOB), payment receipts, and a signed Medical Claim Reimbursement Form.

By Oregon Gov. Kate Brown's executive order, state buildings are now closed to the public at least through April 8. The governor may extend the closure based on the health situation.

The IRS has extended the 2019 tax filing deadline to July 15, 2020. If you have not already filed, do not delay. If you do not file taxes to report any premium tax credits paid for your benefit, you may lose future tax credits. You would then no longer have your health plan paid for by the COFA Premium Assistance Program.
