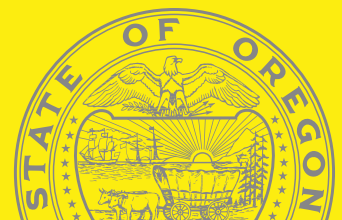
Having a baby or adopting a child means you and your family can get health insurance, even though the regular sign-up period ended Dec. 15. Your deadline to enroll is 60 days after the birth or adoption, so don't put it off even though it will be a busy, exciting time.

You may even qualify for help paying for your coverage.
