

2019 Legislative Session



Passed



- **COFA dental**, HB 2706. Directs DCBS to oversee a study of dental needs, issue an RFI to dental care organizations, and prepare a report by April 15, 2020
- **Health care cost review**, SB 889. Creates a program at OHA to establish a benchmark rate of health care cost growth, and recommend enforcement processes. Calls for a MAC member to serve on the implementation committee.
- **Universal health care**, SB 770. Creates a task force and directs it to design a single-payer system for Oregon and plan a Medicaid buy-in. DCBS director included in task force.

Did not progress to a vote



- **Employer health care contributions**, HB 2269. Would have required large employers to support workers' health care or coverage, or pay a fee. Would have used some of that funding for an additional coverage subsidy.
- **Medicaid buy-in**, HB 2012. Would have developed a plan and recommendations for Medicaid buy-in.
- **Medicaid buy-in and shared responsibility**, HB 2009. Would have created a Medicaid buy-in program and an individual mandate.
